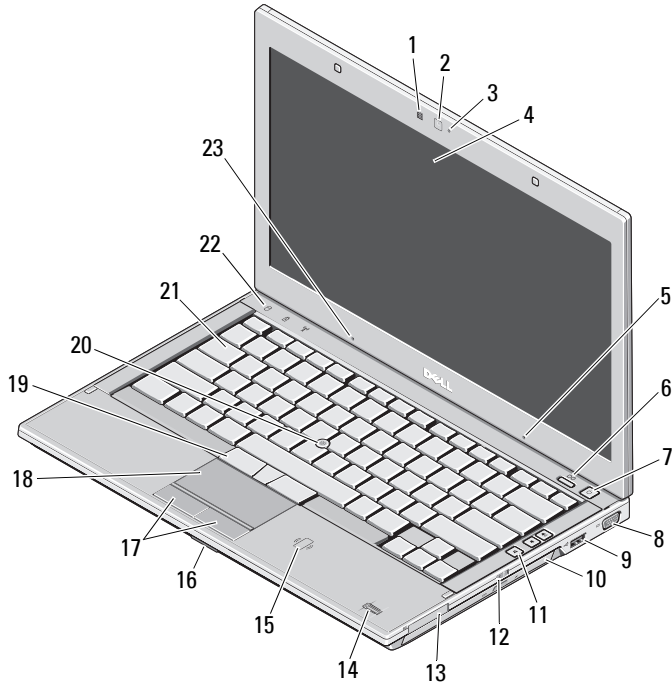

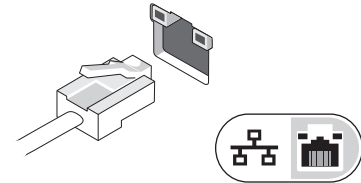
- 1 Connect the AC adapter to the AC-adapter connector on the portable computer and to the electrical outlet.



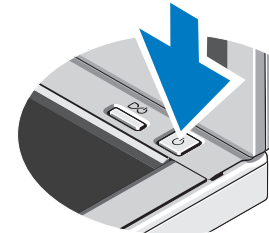
- 3 Connect USB devices, such as a mouse or keyboard (optional).
